This is not your average summer camp. Through dynamic mentorship opportunities, field trips and experiential workshops, 50 accepted students will build proficiency in the fields of science, technology, engineering and math (STEM).

- March 21** Student applications due (including teacher recommendation)
- April 4–9** Applicants are notified whether they are invited for an interview
- April 17** Interview sessions at the Intrepid Museum for invited applicants
- May TBD** Decisions are made and parents/students are contacted
- June 16** Mandatory orientation at the Intrepid Museum
- July 5** First day of program at the Intrepid Museum
- Aug. 12 & 13** Overnight aboard *Intrepid* and last day
