The GOALS (Greater Opportunities Advancing Leadership and Science) for Girls Summer Intensive is a free, application-based summer program for current eighth and ninth grade girls from New York City schools.

Through dynamic mentorship opportunities, field trips and experiential workshops, 50 accepted students will build proficiency in the fields of science, technology, engineering and math (STEM), develop presentation and communication skills, and meet influential women in STEM.

- March 19** Student applications due (including teacher recommendation)
- April 9–13** Applicants are notified whether they are invited for an interview
- April 22 & 29** Interview sessions at the Intrepid Museum for invited applicants
- May TBD** Decisions are made and parents/students are contacted
- June 14** Mandatory orientation at the Intrepid Museum
- July 9** First day of program at the Intrepid Museum
- Aug. 17–18** Overnight aboard *Intrepid* and last day
